# Pastor's Corner

***August is still summertime ... but***  
there are always those sights and  
sounds that remind us that fall and an-  
other school year and homecomings  
and the football season and Labor Day  
are right around the corner ... and  
***Christmas is only 20 weeks away!***

Some of the dates I want to share with  
you as fall approaches include:

**CONFIRMATION REGISTRATION AND  
ORIENTATION for all 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>**

***grade confirmands and their par-  
ents: Wednesday, September 7,  
2011, at 7:00PM.*** Classes will be held  
on most Wednesday evenings from 7:00  
-8:30 through the end of April, 2012.  
8<sup>th</sup> grade confirmands will be confirmed  
on ***Sunday, May 6, 2012.*** During the  
months of September through Decem-  
ber, we will study the ***Apostles' Creed,***  
***ecumenism*** and our ecumenical broth-  
ers and sisters like Roman Catholics

and the Orthodox faith communities, **interfaith dialogue** with our brothers and sisters in the Jewish and Islam communities, and we'll talk about what "**saint**" means and think about what the **witness** of some of the saints from the early days of Christianity means for us in today's world.

**FIRST COMMUNION CLASSES for 5<sup>th</sup> grade students (and for older students) will be held on Tuesdays, October 11, 18, and 25, from 7:30-8:30PM.** Classes are currently scheduled to last for one hour. First communion Sunday will be Reformation Sunday, October 30, 2011.

**NEW MEMBER INQUIRY SESSIONS will be held on the third Sunday of each month following the 10:00AM service (September 18, October 16, and November 20.)** Folks who are interested in becoming a member of the Lutheran Church of the Master by **transfer** (from a congregation in a denomination in fellowship with the ELCA) ... by **baptism** (if not already baptized) ... or by **reaffirmation of faith** (if from a congregation in a denomination not in fellowship with the ELCA.) These will be identical sessions, so a person or a family only needs to attend one.

And, of course, we resume the 8:30AM/10:00AM worship schedule and Sunday School classes on **Rally Day, September 11<sup>th</sup>.**

# Christian Education

## SUNDAY SCHOOL

While students are enjoying a break for the summer, the Christian education planning team is preparing for the coming school year. A survey of students, parents, teachers, and shepherds showed that they want to continue the workshop rotation method. With this system, the same Bible story is repeated in different ways, such as art, drama, cooking, games, or puppets for four or five weeks. Children remember and understand the story because they hear it more than once. They don't get bored, because they learn it in a different way each time.

Teachers like the rotation model, too. They lead the workshop that matches their talents and plan only one lesson, teaching it to a different group each week for about a month. Then they're done, unless they want to teach another lesson during the next rotation.

Since the children have a different teacher each week, shepherds go with the same group of kids through all the workshops. The shepherds provide stability and security. They might call children when they are absent, send birthday cards, and also be a helping hand for the teacher.



The workshop rotation model is used for children through grade 4. Fifth and sixth graders use a different format that meets the social, emotional, and spiritual needs of middle school students.
